

Who are Holiday Explorers?

Holiday Explorers Inc, is a non-profit association established in 1988. Providing holidays for South Australians with intellectual disability over 16 years of age, we offer capacity and skill building opportunities and life changing experiences.

How much do the holidays cost?

CHSP MyAgedCare Clients: For our clients over 65 years referred to us by MyAgedCare and accessing CHSP funding will have part of the trip or event covered by the CHSP funding.

CHSP MyAgedCare Client Gap: The gap covers items that are not covered by CHSP funding and is payable prior to the trip. The above fees don't cover personal purchases.

Who would I be going with on my holiday?

You'll be going with at least one other person and two or more volunteer Support Staff but most often in a group made up of five people and two volunteer Support Staff. Where practical, you will be participating with people in the same age group with similar interests. Support Staff are volunteers trained and registered with Holiday Explorers. Paid Support Staff are engaged to provide higher intensity support, as required and additional fees apply.

How do Support Staff find out what assistance I might need on a holiday?

The Support Staff are advised about the assistance you may need by the Holiday Explorers Client Coordinators. You or your nominated Key Contact are required to contact us before each holiday to update this information. The Support Staff are trained to treat information about you in the strictest confidence. They sign a confidentiality agreement, and at the end of the holiday, return all information about you to the Holiday Explorers office where it is securely retained.

Holiday Explorers Privacy Officer is the Chief Executive Officer.

TERMS & CONDITIONS REMINDERS PAYMENT:

Please refer to your Conditions of Membership and Service Agreement for payment and timings. The balance of fees are payable by the date on the itinerary. All fees due before the holiday.

CHANGES IN PRICES AND ITINERARIES:

Holiday Explorers reserves the right to alter prices or itineraries without notice, however will endeavor to provide at least 7 days notice. Holiday Explorers further reserves the right to cancel or withdraw any holiday, or to decline to accept any person on any holiday. In the event of Holiday Explorers cancelling a holiday on which Clients are booked, at least 7 days notice will be provided unless cancellation is due to an extreme high risk event and a full refund will be provided.
